All Hanuman Fellowship members as of August 2022 were automatically made Statutory members and will continue in that category so long as they renew their membership each year.

New Members are also welcome to join the Hanuman Fellowship as Supporting Members. They may do so by completing the Supporting Member Application and paying the annual dues. Individuals who wish to become a new Statutory (voting) Members are asked to submit an application to the Board of Directors. In order to be eligible, new Statutory Members need to have been a Supporting Member and/or have actively participated in the activities of the Fellowship for at least two (2) years and must be sponsored by a current Statutory Member.
