The Hanuman Fellowship is a community dedicated to the attainment of peace. In order to attain this mission and carry forward the teachings of Baba Hari Dass through sadhana, Satsang, and karma yoga, a membership based on commitment and service is essential.

Members are the strength and foundation of the Fellowship and membership is a way of becoming involved in the service of maintaining and developing the programs and facilities we offer to serve the broader community.

In August 2022, the Hanuman Fellowship Bylaws were revised creating two broad categories of membership: Statutory Members and Supporting Members.

Statutory Members are eligible to vote for the Board of Directors and any other transaction requiring the approval of the “members.” All Hanuman Fellowship members as of August 2022 were automatically made Statutory members and will continue in that category so long as they renew their membership each year.

New Members are also welcome to join the Hanuman Fellowship as Supporting Members. They may do so by completing the Supporting Member Application and paying the annual dues. Individuals who wish to become a new Statutory (voting) Members are asked to submit an application to the Board of Directors. In order to be eligible, new Statutory Members need to have been a Supporting Member and/or have actively participated in the activities of the Fellowship for at least two (2) years and must be sponsored by a current Statutory Member.
